Jubilee Year Parish Walking Pilgrimage: Saturday, June 14

As part of the Church's celebration of the 2025 Jubilee Year, I warmly invite you to join us for a Parish Walking Pilgrimage from Stella Maris Parish Church to Saint Mary's Cathedral Basilica on Saturday, June 14. We will begin our walk at 9:00 AM, journey together in prayer and reflection, and celebrate Mass at the Cathedral at 12:15 PM.

What is a Jubilee Year?

A Jubilee Year is a special year of grace, traditionally held every 25 years, dating back to the year 1300. It is a time the Church sets aside for renewal, marked by pilgrimage, prayer, reconciliation, and acts of mercy. It is an invitation to return to the essentials: God's mercy, the joy of the Gospel, and the hope we have in Christ.

Our late Pope Francis declared 2025 a Jubilee Year of Hope, inspired by Saint Paul's words: "Hope does not disappoint" (Romans 5:5). In this year, we are invited to become Pilgrims of Hope, journeying in faith, witnessing to the love of Christ, and sowing seeds of hope in a world longing for peace and healing.

Throughout the year, Catholics around the world will be making pilgrimages to designated churches, praying for the Church and the world, and seeking a deeper encounter with God. The pilgrimage to Saint Mary's Cathedral Basilica, one of our local Jubilee sites, is one such opportunity.

Whether you've walked many pilgrimages or none at all, this is a chance to journey together, physically and spiritually, as one parish, unified in faith.

Come walk with us. Come be a pilgrim of hope.

Stella Maris Parish to Host Relic of Saint André Bessette (Brother Andre) Wednesday, July 30, 2025

We are thrilled to announce that Stella Maris Parish will host a relic of Saint André Bessette this summer as part of a special Archdiocesan-wide tour from July 25 to 31, 2025.

Saint Brother Andre was a humble religious brother of the Congregation of Holy Cross. Born in 1845 in rural Quebec, he was frail and poorly educated, yet became known throughout Montreal, and eventually the world, for his deep holiness, compassion, and miraculous healings through the intercession of Saint Joseph, to whom he had a profound devotion. In spite of his humble beginnings, Brother André was instrumental in founding Saint Joseph's Oratory, the largest shrine to Saint Joseph in the world. He was canonized in 2010 by Pope Benedict XVI.

Saint André's life reminds us that sanctity does not require worldly power or prestige, only a faithful heart, a life of service, and deep trust in God.

March for Life: RESCHEDULED - New Date is Saturday, June 14th at 1 PM, from St. Mary's Basilica, Spring Garden Rd, to Province House return.

Campaign Life Coalition Nova Scotia (CLC NS) is organizing a provincial March for Life on May 22. At 1PM, Marchers will walk from the meeting point of St. Mary's Cathedral on Spring Garden Rd. to outside Province House where we will peacefully witness to the dignity and humanity of preborn children and pray for an end to abortion.
